Recreate the Energy of Tibetan Monasteries

Like other religious and ritual structures on the Earth, Tibetan monasteries are also activated by cosmic energy. Especially interesting is that their high energetic intensity is obtained by some unknown principle, one that utilizes the use of rotational bodies. There are praying mills built in the monasteries (hollow metal hooks similar to a barrel) that are manually rotated by the monks. There are also small mobile praying mills that are rotated by the help of a string with a weight at the end. Could it be possible to recreate the cosmic energy of the praying mills in other places, using similar structures of simple design?

Let us test this hypothesis by attempting two easy experiments. The effects of the small mobile praying mill can be replicated from a metal can with a volume of about 200 ml. We empty the can through a small opening and then make 2 holes through its middle that are in line with each other. Insert a screw-driver through these holes. At the bottom part of the cans' side we make an opening where we attach a string about 10 cm long. At the end of this string we attach a small weight. If an assistant manually makes the can rotate, we can measure huge increases in the size of the aura every minute the can is turned. The size of the aura bears a relationship to the auric capacity of cellular membranes.

Another easy experiment can also recreate the same function of great praying mills, which can also be used



to manipulate the energetic intensity of the matter of the monastery, unlike the small mills. To do this experiment we need an old LP record player or some other turning device and a metal pot that we put on the turntable. Using dowsing rods* we can make three identifications of aura that replicate the energetic function of the praying mills (something that is not unlike the "bell effect" from the 15th century):

1. when the turntable with the pot is not turning
2. when it is turning with the pot upside down
3. when it is turning with the pot in a normal position

* Dowsing rods can be made by taking wire 3mm in diameter and 24cm in length, bending it at the middle so it becomes U shaped. An example can be found at www.miroslavprovod.com

Recreate the Energy of Tibetan Monasteries (cont)

The rotational effect of the turntable produces cosmic energy and is one of many examples of energy generation that work in a similar way (astronomical bodies, wheels of motor vehicles, trains, turbines and tornadoes are all examples of rotational bodies). If we combine the previously gained energetic knowledge with concepts of rotational energy we can say that the motion of matter produces cosmic energy. In a previous article (Dowsing versus Aura) I describe the growing aura of a stationary automobile and how when the automobile is moving it's necessary to add the new knowledge to aura. In the case of praying mill structures the levels of energy generation could go beyond all known energetic boundaries, indeed insights gained from recent research suggest that the energetic and chemical properties of cosmic energy are larger than we might imagine.

The experiments described may have demonstrated that rotational bodies can produce energy; but what might the impacts of the high Tibetan altitudes be in creating something unique and not produced by other religious structures? It's not just important information, which increases knowledge about the properties of cosmic energy in high latitude mountain regions, but it also makes us think about the possibility for new experiments.

Traditionally fire is used to increase the energetic intensity of matter in the monasteries during butyraceous

sacrifices. Candles are used in other religious centres for the same reason. The function of monasteries in Tibet is not different from other religious structures in that they concentrate cosmic energy to a point that enables people to recharge their bodily energy. Learning to understand and use these energies might not only create a brighter future for humanity but also bring us a greater understanding of cosmic principles.
